Is this frequency in use? This is (personal call sign).

With Nothing Heard, we will continue.

This is station WB2EOC (give the call phonetically), calling the Monroe County ARES / RACES Net.

Good evening, my name is (name) and my call sign is (give your call phonetically) and I am located in (Your Location).

Is there any emergency or priority traffic please call WB2EOC (Wait).

Hearing none we will proceed.

The ARES / RACES Net is a directed net. Please do not transmit without the permission of net control unless you have emergency or priority traffic.

If you must leave the net, please inform net control before doing so. Comments concerning net operations should be directed to NET Control at Vicepresident@monroecountyemcomm.org.

(If an alternate net control signed up, follow this script.)

I am now looking for (alternate call sign from Schedule) to serve as alternate net control. Please call WB2EOC now. (Wait)

(If an alternate net control did not sign up, follow this script.)

I am now looking for an ARES member to act as ALTERNATE Net control. Please call WB2EOC to volunteer NOW. (Wait for volunteer, if none then proceed without one.)

The ARES Net meets every Thursday at 1900 hours - 7:00 pm Local on the N2MPE repeater system, VHF146.61 (-) and UHF 444.45 (+) 110.9 Hz.

This net is for the purpose of practicing handling health, welfare, and intelligence traffic, testing equipment and communication readiness, as well as practicing directed net PROTOCOL.

When checking in tonight please give the NET call sign (WB2EOC) let up on your push to talk and listen to ensure you are not doubling, like this. (Let up mic) If you hear no-one transmitting, re-key your mic and state your call sign, name and location by town or village.

I am now ready to accept checkins.

I will call for contacts by quadrants of the county, NE, NW, SW, SE, then out of county checkins. The dividing line for East West is the Genesee River, and the North South dividing line is the Erie Canal.

Operators in the NW section please call WB2EOC now.

(Listen for check in and acknowledge name, call sign, and town. Information shall be logged on the Google sheet. Continue as needed until no more checkins.)

(Repeat for NE section.)

(Repeat for SW section.)

(Repeat for SE section.)

(Repeat for outside of Monroe County.)

(Repeat for additional checkins, inside or outside of Monroe County.)

Anyone with words for the net, please call WB2EOC now.

(Make announcements for any upcoming ARES activities now.)

Last call for checkins, please call WB2EOC now. (Wait)

With no other check-ins or net business, I will now proceed to close this session of the ARES Net. We had _____ check-ins (pull total from Google sheet).
