( NC - Be prepared to record list of calls by quadrant.)

Operators in the NW quadrant, please call WB2EOC, now.

Repeat for each: NE, SW, SE.

Repeat for Outside of Monroe County.

Repeat for Additional check-ins, Inside or Outside Monroe County.

Anyone with words for the net, please call WB2EOC now.

( NC - Ask if a digital station would operate a session AFTER NET is Officially CLOSED.)

( NC - This is the time for announcements of upcoming activities.)
